### Content Standards

#### Prohibited Content

You agree to not make any Submissions that:

- **Harmful Applications:** Could cause any harm, including physical, emotional, or financial harm
- **Deceptive Content:** Mislead users about capabilities, origins, or purposes
- **Hateful Content:** Promote discrimination, harassment, or violence

#### Ethical AI Use

You will:

- Promote beneficial outcomes
- Consider potential misuse scenarios
- Include safeguards against harmful applications

### Quality Expectations

Before you make a Submission, you will:

- Check for edge cases
- Ensure consistent and reliable performance

When making a Submission, you must make sure your Submission:

- Functions as described in your description and/or documentation
- Includes clear instructions for use and implementation
- Clearly indicates third party dependencies and document any external data connections

### Transparency Requirements

Every submission must include:

- **Title and Description:** Let us know how it works! Provide a summary of the intended use (examples are always welcomed)
- **Limitations:** Known constraints, edge cases, or failure modes
- **Setup Instructions:** Step-by-step implementation guide if the Submission is a template

Example documentation:

Model: GPT-5 based administrative agent  
Training Data: School policies  
Limitations: May struggle with technical jargon  
Intended Use: General policy questions

## Collaboration Guidelines

You will:

- Share appropriate knowledge generously
- Credit collaborators appropriately

## Intellectual Property & Attribution

### Licensing Requirements

When necessary, you will:

- Specify a clear license for your submission
- Recommended licenses: Permissive open-source licenses (MIT, Apache 2.0)
- State any commercial use permissions or restrictions

## Special Considerations

### Sensitive Domains

For professional or sensitive submissions (e.g., healthcare, finance, or legal, etc.), you will:

- Confirm that your Submission does not violate any legal terms of any third party service utilized by your Submission
- Include prominent disclaimers
- Document any regulatory compliance requirements
- Emphasize professional oversight needs (human in the loop)
- Never claim to replace professional advice or services

### Age-Appropriate Content

- Clearly label Submissions with age considerations
- Implement appropriate content filters
